

Migrant Workers Representatives Counseling Meeting for GFATM

7th Round Application

Meeting Minutes

Date: April 27, 2007

Place: No.2 meeting room, Second floor, Chinese CDC

Chair: Yu Dongbao

Attendance: Representatives and experts from 'Home of Migrant workers', 'Hotline for solving trouble', 'Home of Female Migrant Workers', 'Action Hotline', 'Gender Health Research Institute'(see the attachment for the name list)

Three issues have been discussed during this meeting:

1. Should we apply for the 7th round GFATM project?
2. Where is the project supposed to be implemented?
3. How to implement the project?

The meeting has been chaired by Yu Dongbao, Director of Planning and M&E division of SCAWCO. Firstly, he has introduced the background of GFATM and present implementation situation of successively applied 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th round GFATM projects. Mr. Ha Xiaosi of Labor and Social Insurance Department has introduced present basic situation of migrant workers in China.

Yu Dongbao has introduced and helped the discussion of the topics above. Through the discussion, the consistent agreement has been attained as below:

1. The application for the 7th round GFATM has been considered meaningful, especially to the migrant worker, and the migrant worker representatives have expressed sincere thanks from the bottom of their heart.
2. It has been suggested to conduct the work both at receiving and sending areas, and the receiving areas should be the focus. The cities with huge migrant population such as Guangzhou and Shenzhen have been suggested to be considered as the candidate

project cities.

3. Target population should aim at migrant workers centralized places such as factory, construction building sites and mine, at the same time, through the street committee, social community and migrant worker organization, to conduct work to decentralized migrant workers (fending food and fruit, etc) at suburb area.

4. The working mode of migrant worker organizations has been recommended to be as reference to conduct the work, such as peer education, distribution of free poker cards etc which are more acceptable working modes for migrant workers. Different working methods should be taken to aim at migrant population with different age and occupation. It has been suggested to pay more attention to the migrant workers' voice.

5. Government advocated and civil organizations participated working mechanism should be established.
